## Tips for embossed embroidery

For a defined embossed look, you will need to use a heavier weight fabric with a high pile, such as, terry cloth, polar fleece, sweatshirt material, etc.

The best types of backing to use are tear-away, fibrous wash away, and cut-away backings.

Also, some prefer to add a water-soluble stabilizer, such as Solvy, on the top of the fabric, to prevent the stitches from sinking into the nap of the fabric. However, we achieved better results not using Solvy, as it seemed to prevent the highs and lows in the fabric.

This, of course, is your preference.
